As chair of BC Ferries under the Gordon
Campbell Liberals, David Emerson ended the
long-standing policy of building new ships in
British Columbia, which created jobs and
investment.

The result – three new Super-C class ferries
worth \$542 million are being built today in a
German shipyard, costing our province 5500
direct and indirect jobs.

And the Liberals failed to deliver on a promise of
a new National Shipbuilding policy. That could
result in three new navy supply ships worth \$2
billion being built in a foreign country.

Then Emerson and Dosanjh, along with other
BC Liberal MPs, refused to even hold public
hearings into the \$6.9 billion sale of BC's
natural gas distributor Terasen to giant U.S.
energy corporation Kinder Morgan, let alone
block the sale.

Send the Liberals a clear message – that we
don't elect BC MPs to export family-supporting
BC jobs.
